Daily cruise report (31 January 2020)



1. Objective

Since yesterday afternoon the Maria S Merian and the Atalante are sailing together, half mile distant, crossing the deep blue in search of its turbulent secrets. We live in synchrony, deploying instruments into the water and into the sky. This afternoon, we saw the cloudkite leaving the Maria S Merian to his rendezvous with the clouds (see picture below). In the meanwhile, we continue to analyze the large inflow of data that reveals an ocean and atmosphere, certainly different, but somewhat linked together. While we hunt the hiding groundhog eddies and the secret of clouds, we continue to discover new ocean dynamical structures (see the figure below) that suddenly appear at depth.

2. Synoptic Situation

Moderate to quite strong trade winds. Sand dust. Easterly wind 15-20kt. The waves are about 5-6 feet. Mesoscale cloud patterns (18utc): in transition between gravel and flower.

4. Instrument Status


All instruments seem to work well. Today Vaisala radiosounding reception was more stable.

5. Outlook


We will continue to sail in parallel with Maria S. Merian alternating MVP, uCTD, VMP deployments and radiosoundings.
